Installation Instructions

- 1. If possible, remove vacuum manufacturer's vinyl bumper.
- Thoroughly clean vacuum-head with a non-oil-based cleaning solution. Clean again with the provided alcohol wipes.
 Note: Dirt will prevent Velcro® adhesive from adhering well.
- Peel plastic backing from Velcro® and attach strips directly to the hard plastic frame of the vacuum-head as shown in Figure 1.
 Note: Adhesives adhere better to plastic than vinyl.
- For best results, install VacuBumper[™] 24-hours after attaching Velcro[®].
 Note: Adhesive reaches maximum strength 24-hours after Velcro[®] installation.
- 5. Center, stretch and attach the bumper as shown in Figures 2 and 3.
 - a. Bumper must completely cover the Velcro® to prevent dirt from attaching to adhesive.
 - b. Bumper must not hang below the vacuum-head, as this will impede the vacuum's performance.

Care Instructions

Remove dust and debris with a lint-roller, or machine wash and line dry.
